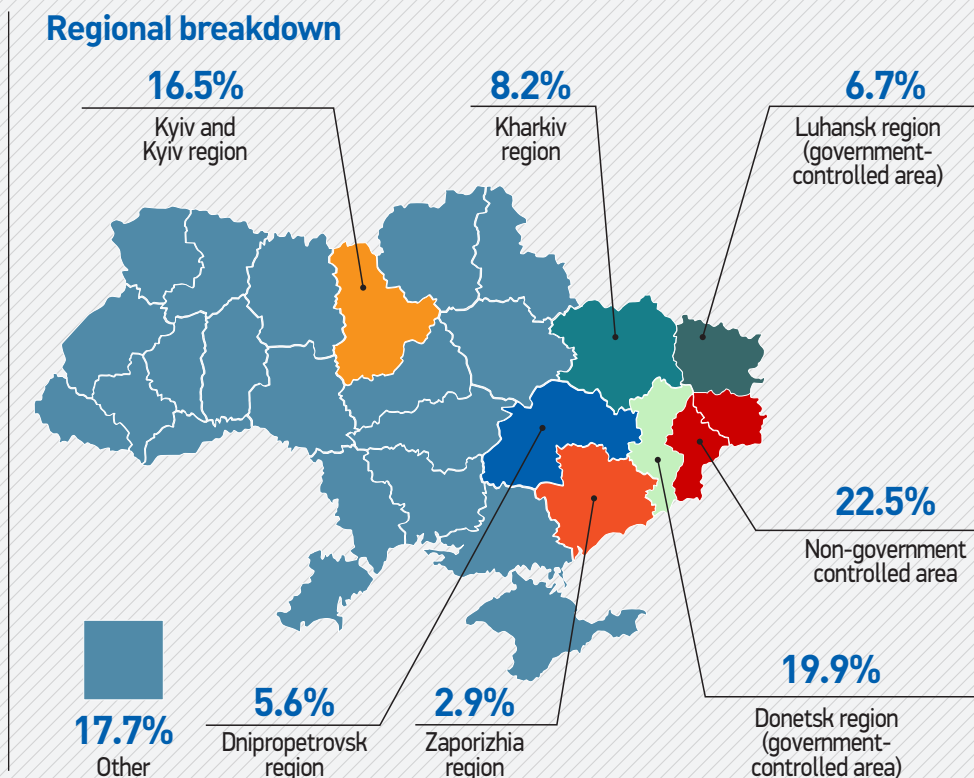

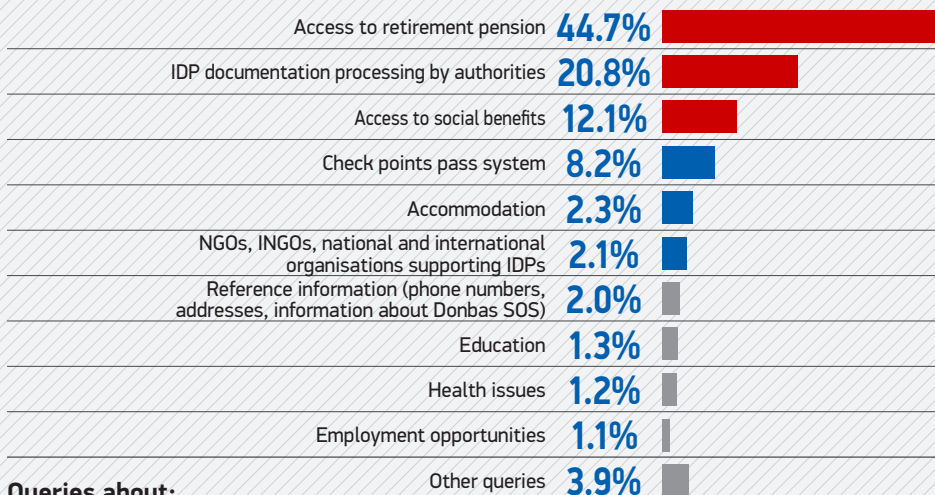
The DONBAS SOS Hotline has been supported by IOM since March 2015 for the purpose of providing impartial, comprehensive, and up-to-date information for IDPs. Since then it has received a total of **71,450** calls.



The share of calls concerning access to retirement pension increased from 11.9% in April 2018 to 44.7% in May 2018, which could be related to changes in the mechanism for verification of IDPs eligibility for pensions currently being introduced by the Pension Fund of Ukraine.



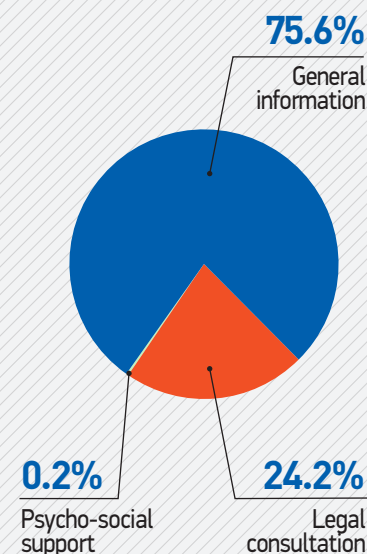

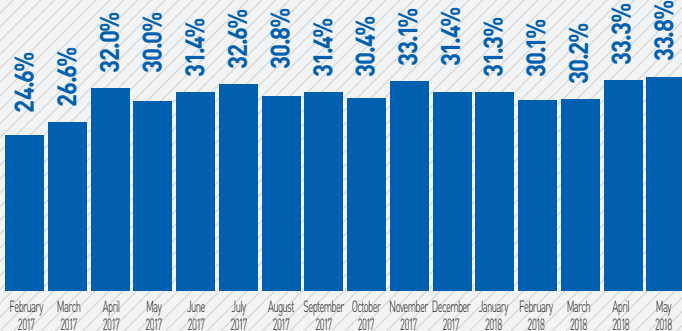

Further analysis was conducted on calls received and disaggregated by gender. The below provides an overview of the total number of calls and subject of queries from males and females.

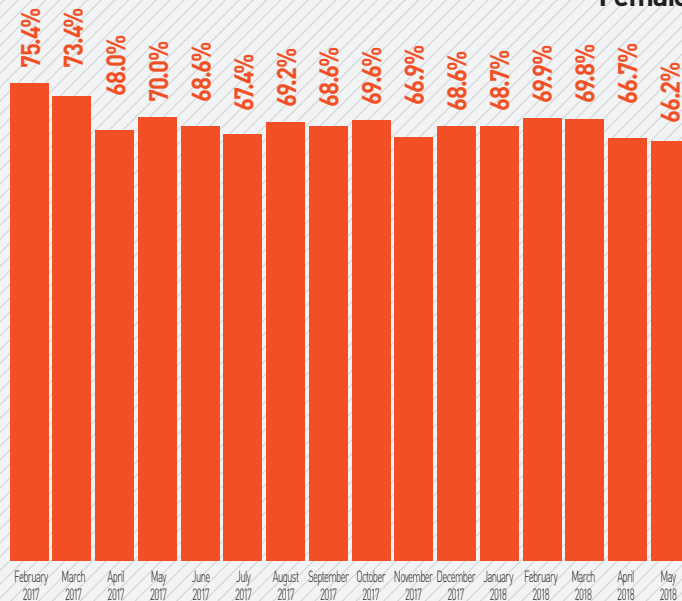


**The share of calls from females was significantly larger throughout the whole reporting period.**

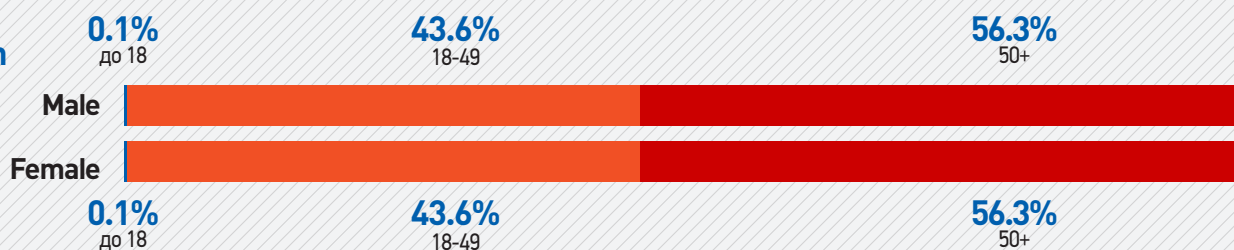

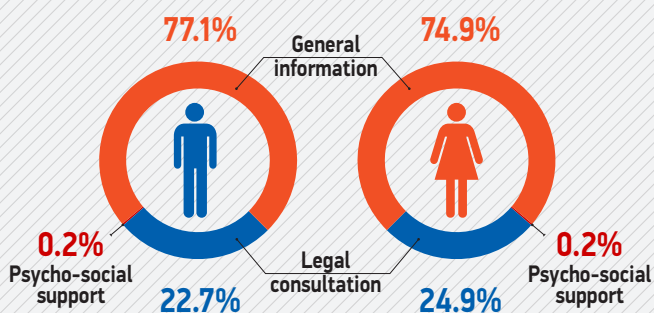

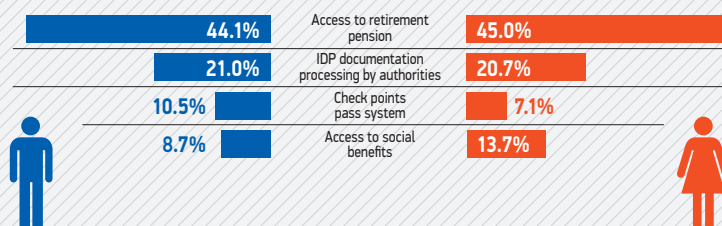
### Age distribution
