Question: What kind of legal advice did you imply?

IOM’s Official Answer:

A draft of the contract between IOM and a beneficiary (person who has been provided with a loan under revolving fund project) needs to be presented, outlining IOM and beneficiary rights and responsibilities, conditions for the contract termination in case the equipment procured with a loan is not properly used, collateral, payment modalities, etc.
